- 16 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Austin has truly exhibited a commitment to the  
17 scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a  
18 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader  
20 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.
