5 officer; and

7 Lassiter High School, Reinhart College, and Kennesaw State University; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he enjoyed swimming, racquetball, reading, and working out and was
9 passionate about music, fitness, family, friends, and his dogs; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he was preceded in death by his father, Steven Louis Callahan, and grandfather
11 Dennis Callahan; and he is survived by his parents, John and Darlene Rogers; sister, Candice;
12 grandparents, Douglas and Florence Callahan and Carolyn Callahan; and a host of other
13 family and friends; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
15 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
16 family and friends were admired by others; and
- 17 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
18 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and, by the example he made of his life, he
19 made this world a better place in which to live.
