A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-5-311 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 creation of county boards of equalization, duties, review of assessments, and appeals, so as
- 3 to provide that a taxpayer may submit a certain appraisal in support of an appeal; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 48-5-311 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to creation of
- 8 county boards of equalization, duties, review of assessments, and appeals, is amended in
- 9 subsection (e) by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:
- 10 "(8.1) The taxpayer or his or her agent or representative may submit in support of his or
- her appeal an appraisal given, signed, and certified as such by a real property appraiser
- as classified by the Georgia Real Estate Commission and the Georgia Real Estate
- Appraisers Board which was performed not later than nine months prior to the property
- 14 <u>tax notification provided for in Code Section 48-5-306</u>. The board must consider the
- 15 <u>appraisal upon request."</u>

SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
