A RESOLUTION

1 Expressing support for an eastern corridor in metropolitan Atlanta, Georgia, for bicycle
2 traffic; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, with the defeat of the transportation special purpose local option sales tax, a
4 bicycle trail is needed more than ever; and

5 WHEREAS, there is a need for an eastern corridor in metropolitan Atlanta for bicycle traffic,
6 including bicycle connectivity between major cities such as Atlanta, Decatur, Clarkston, and
7 Stone Mountain, by the PATH Foundation; and

8 WHEREAS, with the diversity of businesses and educational opportunities, bicyclists
9 commute to and from work, school, and college, as well as bike to run errands, visit parks
10 and recreation centers, and many more activities; and

11 WHEREAS, although most people assume that the Stone Mountain PATH trail was
12 completed long ago, the trail over and approaching I-285 has not been completed, making
13 these areas particularly dangerous for both bicyclists and motorists.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
15 the members of this body express support for an eastern corridor in metropolitan Atlanta,
16 Georgia, for bicycle traffic.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
18 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the public and the press.
