## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing support for an eastern corridor in metropolitan Atlanta, Georgia, for bicycle
- 2 traffic; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, with the defeat of the transportation special purpose local option sales tax, a
- 4 bicycle trail is needed more than ever; and
- 5 WHEREAS, there is a need for an eastern corridor in metropolitan Atlanta for bicycle traffic,
- 6 including bicycle connectivity between major cities such as Atlanta, Decatur, Clarkston, and
- 7 Stone Mountain, by the PATH Foundation; and
- 8 WHEREAS, with the diversity of businesses and educational opportunities, bicyclists
- 9 commute to and from work, school, and college, as well as bike to run errands, visit parks
- and recreation centers, and many more activities; and
- 11 WHEREAS, although most people assume that the Stone Mountain PATH trail was
- 12 completed long ago, the trail over and approaching I-285 has not been completed, making
- 13 these areas particularly dangerous for both bicyclists and motorists.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 15 the members of this body express support for an eastern corridor in metropolitan Atlanta,
- 16 Georgia, for bicycle traffic.
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the public and the press.
