A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 2 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to discipline of students in elementary and secondary education, so as to
- 3 require annual reporting of bullying incidents; to provide for criminal offenses; to provide
- 4 for input into antibullying strategies by school councils; to provide for related matters; to
- 5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 2 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to discipline of students in elementary and secondary education, is amended in Code
- 10 Section 20-2-740, relating to an annual report by local boards of education regarding
- disciplinary and placement actions and an annual study by the Department of Education, by
- revising subsections (a) and (b) as follows:
- 13 "(a) Each local board of education shall file an annual report, by August 1 of each year,
- with the Department of Education regarding disciplinary and placement actions taken
- during the prior school year. Such report shall classify the types of actions into the
- 16 following categories:
- 17 (1) Actions in which a student was assigned to in-school suspension;
- 18 (2) Actions in which a student was suspended for a period of ten days or less;
- 19 (3) Actions in which a student was suspended for a period of more than ten days but not
- beyond the current school quarter or semester;
- 21 (4) Actions in which a student was expelled beyond the current school quarter or
- semester but not permanently expelled;
- 23 (5) Actions in which a student was permanently expelled;
- 24 (6) Actions in which a student was placed in an alternative educational setting;
- 25 (7) Actions in which a student was suspended from riding the bus;
- 26 (8) Actions in which corporal punishment was administered; and

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27 (9) Actions in which a student was removed from class pursuant to subsection (b) of

- 28 Code Section 20-2-738; and
- 29 (10) Actions in which a student was disciplined for bullying, as defined by Code Section
- 30 <u>20-2-751.4</u>.
- 31 (b) For each category of disciplinary or placement action listed in paragraphs (1) through
- $\frac{(9)(10)}{(10)}$ of subsection (a) of this Code section, the local board shall provide the following
- information: the number of students subject to the type of disciplinary or placement action;
- 34 the age and grade level of such students; such students' race and gender; and the number
- of students subject to the type of disciplinary action in each category who were eligible for
- 36 free or reduced price lunches under federal guidelines. For each action listed in paragraph
- 37 (9) of subsection (a) of this Code section, the local board shall also provide information
- regarding the decisions of placement review committees and the disciplinary and placement
- decisions made by principals or their designees. The data required by this Code section
- shall be reported separately for each school within the local school system and collected
- and reported in compliance with the requirements of 20 U.S.C. Sections 1232g and 1232h."

42 SECTION 2.

- 43 Said part is further amended in Code Section 20-2-751.4, relating to policies prohibiting
- bullying, assignment to alternative school, and notice, by adding new subsections to read as
- 45 follows:
- 46 "(b.1) The local board of education shall require the principal of each school to regularly
- 47 report incidents of bullying which occurred in such school to the school council. Such
- 48 reporting shall not include any individually identifying information but shall only be
- 49 aggregated data relating to the number and type of bullying incidents and the types of
- 50 <u>discipline imposed.</u> The school council and the school principal shall work together to
- develop and implement strategies to prevent bullying."
- 52 "(h) A student in grades six through 12 who commits the offense of bullying for the third
- 53 <u>time in a school year shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Such student who commits any</u>
- 54 <u>subsequent offense of bullying in such school year shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of a</u>
- 55 <u>high and aggravated nature.</u>"

56 SECTION 3.

57 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
