#### A RESOLUTION

14 WHEREAS, she has a Bachelor of Music degree in voice from Wesleyan College and later  
15 earned an MBA from California State University, and she returned to Macon to receive her  
16 Juris Doctor degree from Mercer's Walter F. George School of Law; and

17 WHEREAS, her community involvement includes membership in the Choral Society of  
18 Middle Georgia and the Rotary Club of Macon, serving as a board member of the Macon  
19 Theatre and former board member of CWN, supporting Georgia Legal Services and Bibb  
20 County Arts Community through donations, and staying active in the music program at  
21 Vineville Methodist Church; and

22 WHEREAS, Dianne also gives support and inspiration to her niece, who is attending medical  
23 school and will graduate in 2014; and

24 WHEREAS, she is an outstanding individual and an inspiration to women, and it is  
25 abundantly fitting and proper that she be appropriately recognized.
