## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Children's Advocacy Centers of Georgia and recognizing February 20, 2013,  
2 as Children's Advocacy Centers Day at the capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Children's Advocacy Centers of Georgia promotes a comprehensive approach  
4 to the intervention, investigation, prosecution, and treatment of child abuse including cases  
5 involving physical abuse, neglect, sexual abuse, sexual exploitation, Internet crimes, child  
6 fatalities, and children who have witnessed domestic violence and homicide; and

8 and experienced professionals who are trained to provide comprehensive and compassionate

12 focused on best practices in prevention, intervention, and treatment of child abuse; and

14 organization and its numerous contributions to the citizens of this state be appropriately  
15 recognized.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
17 the members of this body commend Children's Advocacy Centers of Georgia for their
