A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Hunter Chadwick; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Hunter Chadwick is a participant in the 2013 Capitol Art Exhibit; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the Capitol Art Exhibit is the annual show put on by the Georgia Art Educators
4 Association, where each member teacher submits the work of two of their best students for
5 the exhibition; and
- 6 WHEREAS, submitted artwork remains in the Twin Towers for approximately one month,
7 during which a formal reception is held for the students and their families; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Hunter is currently a senior at Ridgeland High School in Walker County,
9 Georgia; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he has successfully completed all of his credits to graduate at the end of first
11 semester; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Hunter was nominated for the Georgia Governor's Honors Program last year
13 and advanced to the state level of the competition; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he has taken Art 1 and 2 as well as Pottery 1; and
- 15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
16 remarkable Georgian, whose area of expertise is graphite drawings and comic strips, be
17 appropriately recognized as an affirmation of a successful young artist with a promising
18 career.

20 recognize and commend Hunter Chadwick for his participation in the 2013 Capitol Art
21 Exhibit and extend to him their most sincere best wishes for future success.
