A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Zoe Pace; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Zoe Pace is a participant in the 2013 Capitol Art Exhibit; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the Capitol Art Exhibit is the annual show put on by the Georgia Art Educators
4 Association, where each member teacher submits the work of two of their best students for
5 the exhibition; and

7 during which a formal reception is held for the students and their families; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Zoe was born on May 8, 1997, and is currently a sophomore at LaFayette High
9 School in Walker County, Georgia; and
- 10 WHEREAS, her natural ability and talent are exceptional, and her craftsmanship and eye for
11 balance and technique are methodical and with purpose; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Zoe is in the beginning of her art course studies as a high school student and
13 just completed Art I last semester; and
- 14 WHEREAS, her large-scale drawing of Marilyn Monroe, which will be on display, was done
15 in ebony pencil and took several hours; and
- 16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
17 remarkable Georgian, whose art was chosen due to its immense impact, be appropriately
18 recognized as an affirmation of a successful young artist with a promising career.

20 recognize and commend Zoe Pace for her participation in the 2013 Capitol Art Exhibit and
