A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the State YMCA of Georgia's Center for Civic Engagement;

2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State YMCA of Georgia's Center for Civic Engagement sponsors the Youth

4 Assembly, a model state legislature for high school students in which students serve as

5 legislators, justices, attorneys, and lobbyists; and

6 WHEREAS, participants in the Youth Assembly may run for the offices of Youth Governor,

7 Lt. Governor, and Speaker of the House; and

8 WHEREAS, students participating in the Youth Assembly are also given the opportunity to
9 explore the role the media plays in government by participating in the production of a daily
10 newspaper; and

WHEREAS, established in 1946, the Youth Assembly conference takes place in the historic
halls of the Georgia State Capitol, providing participants with an experience of a lifetime;
and

WHEREAS, the 68th Youth Assembly was made up of many bright and eager young leaders, 14 15 including Youth Governor Ellen Wilson, Lt. Governor Jacy Donaldson, Speaker of the House Justin Wallace, President Pro Tem Sutton Trulock, Speaker Pro Tem Chandler Stone, 16 Chief Justice Jessie Adams, Associate Justice Wyatt Martin, Secretary of the Senate 17 Philadelphia Brewer, Assistant Secretary of the Senate Jessie Bulley, Senate Floor Leader 18 19 Cameron Johnson, Senate Doorkeeper Kayson Manning, Assistant Senate Doorkeeper 20 Courtney Carter, Senate Messenger Jordan Bracewell, Clerk of the House Martie Rogers, 21 House Floor Leader Lizzy Mahoney, House Doorkeeper Brandon Moye, and House 22 Messenger Samantha Green; and
