

House Bill 479

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to provide for the Board of Education of Forsyth County and to consolidate
2 and restate provisions of law relating to the board, approved March 24, 1992 (Ga. L. 1992,
3 p. 5052), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 18, 2007 (Ga. L. 2007, p. 3783),
4 so as to change the compensation of the chairperson and members of the board; to remove
5 compensation for per diem expenses; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective
6 date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act to provide for the Board of Education of Forsyth County and to consolidate and
9 restate provisions of law relating to the board, approved March 24, 1992 (Ga. L. 1992, p.
10 5052), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 18, 2007 (Ga. L. 2007, p. 3783),
11 is amended by revising Section 4 to read as follows:

12 "SECTION 4.

13 (a) The chairperson of the Board of Education of Forsyth County shall receive as
14 compensation the sum of \$750.00 per month, payable only from tax funds available to the
15 county board of education for educational purposes.

16 (b) Members of the board of education other than the chairperson shall receive as
17 compensation the sum of \$700.00 per month, payable only from tax funds available to the
18 county board of education for educational purposes."

19 **SECTION 2.**

20 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 5 to read as follows:

21 "SECTION 5.

22 While traveling inside or outside the state as a member of the board on business first
23 authorized by a majority of the board, the chairperson or the members shall receive
24 reimbursement for actual expenses necessarily incurred in connection therewith. Such

25 amounts shall be paid only from tax funds available to the county board of education for
26 educational purposes."

27 **SECTION 3.**

28 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2014.

29 **SECTION 4.**

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
