## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Board of Corrections and the Department of Corrections, so as to provide that employees of
- 3 the Department of Corrections serving as certified peace officers may retain their weapons
- 4 under certain circumstances; to authorize the Board of Corrections to promulgate rules and
- 5 regulations; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 2 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Board of
- 9 Corrections and the Department of Corrections, is amended by adding a new Code section
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 "<u>42-2-7.1.</u>
- 12 (a) An employee leaving the service of the department under honorable conditions who
- has accumulated 25 or more years of service with the department as a certified peace
- officer shall be entitled as part of such employee's compensation to retain his or her
- department issued weapon.
- 16 (b) The board is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations for the implementation of
- 17 <u>this Code section.</u>"

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
