1 Commending the Gainesville High School girls golf team on their Class AAA State
2 Championship win and inviting the players and coaches to be recognized by the House of
3 Representatives; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, through perseverance and unwavering determination, the Gainesville High
5 School girls golf team won the Class AAA State Championship; and

6 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of the team is a clear indication of the outstanding
7 athletic ability, the dedication and hard work, and the unity of purpose and spirit of each
8 member of the team and the astute direction of Coach Clay McDonald; and

9 WHEREAS, this is the program's first state title trophy since 2003 and 2004; and

10 WHEREAS, three sophomores and a freshman from the team qualified for the one-day state
11 tournament at Applewood Golf Course, and they beat the rest of the field by eight strokes;

13 WHEREAS, team members Morgan Reece's 80 and Meg Callahan's 86 gave the team a 166
14 total to beat runner-up Carrollton, which finished at 174; and

15 WHEREAS, as this magnificent team earned its well-deserved reputation for excellence by
16 performing with precision and dedication over months of training and competition, it is
17 abundantly proper to call them champions.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body commend the Gainesville High School girls golf team on their
20 Class AAA State Championship and invite the players and coaches to be recognized by the
21 House of Representatives on a date and time designated by the Speaker of the House of
22 Representatives.
