A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 4 of Chapter 2 of Title 18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the
- 2 "Uniform Fraudulent Transfers Act," so as to provide for a definition; to clarify that a
- 3 charitable contribution made to a charitable organization shall not be deemed a fraudulent
- 4 transfer when the charitable organization receives such contribution in good faith; to provide
- 5 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 4 of Chapter 2 of Title 18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Uniform
- 9 Fraudulent Transfers Act," is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 10 "<u>18-2-81.</u>
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'charitable organization' means a religious,
- benevolent, philanthropic, patriotic, or eleemosynary organization qualified as tax-exempt
- under Section 501(c)(3) of the federal Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
- 14 (b) A transfer made to a charitable organization shall not be considered fraudulent within
- 15 the meaning of this article and shall not be subject to avoidance, attachment, recapture, or
- other relief when a charitable organization has received such transfer without any
- 17 knowledge that the transfer was made fraudulently within the meaning of this article."

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
