A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Sandy Springs Bar Association and inviting members to
2 be recognized by the House of Representatives; and for other purposes.

15 attorneys is admired by others.

17 the members of this body commend the Sandy Springs Bar Association for its many
18 contributions to the community and invite members to be recognized by the House of
