A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Don Meck; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Don Meck, Ph.D., J.D., ABPP, has long been recognized by the citizens of this
3 state for the crucial role that he has played in leadership, his high ideals, morals, and his deep
4 personal commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and
