The House Committee on Motor Vehicles offers the following substitute to HB 365:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-8-76.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to use
- 2 of safety belts in passenger vehicles, so as to modify the definition of the term "passenger
- 3 vehicle" to which the seat safety belt law applies; to provide for related matters; to provide
- 4 for an effective date and applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 40-8-76.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to use of safety
- 8 belts in passenger vehicles, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
- 9 "(a) As used in this Code section, the term 'passenger vehicle' means every motor vehicle,
- including, but not limited to, pickup trucks, vans, and sport utility vehicles, designed to
- carry ten <u>15</u> passengers or fewer and used for the transportation of persons; provided,
- however, that such term shall not include motorcycles; motor driven cycles; or off-road
- vehicles or pickup trucks being used by an owner, driver, or occupant 18 years of age or
- older in connection with agricultural pursuits that are usual and normal to the user's
- farming operation; and provided, further, that such term shall not include motor vehicles
- designed to carry 11 to 15 passengers which were manufactured prior to July 1, 2013, and
- which as of such date did not have manufacturer installed seat safety belts."
- 18 SECTION 2.
- 19 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2013, and shall apply to offenses occurring on or
- after that date.
- SECTION 3.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
