A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Chapter 10A of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
professional counselors, social workers, and marriage and family therapists, so as to revise
definitions relating to marriage and family therapy; to provide for related matters; to repeal
conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

Chapter 10A of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to professional
counselors, social workers, and marriage and family therapists, is amended in Code Section
43-10A-3, relating to definitions, by revising paragraphs (8) and (17) as follows:

10 "(8) 'Marriage and family therapy' means that specialty which evaluates, diagnoses, and 11 treats emotional and mental problems and conditions, whether cognitive, affective, or 12 behavioral, resolves intrapersonal and interpersonal conflicts, and changes perception, 13 attitudes, and behavior; all within the context of marital and family systems. Marriage and family therapy includes, without being limited to, individual, group, couple, sexual, 14 15 family, and divorce therapy. Marriage and family therapy involves an applied 16 understanding of the dynamics of marital and family systems, including individual psychodynamics, the use of assessment instruments that evaluate marital and family 17 18 functioning, designing and recommending a course of treatment, and the use of 19 psychotherapy and counseling."

"(17) 'The Commission on Accreditation for Marriage and Family Therapy Education'
 means the national accrediting agency for marriage and family therapy education as
 recognized by the United States Department of Education Council for Higher Education
 Accreditation."
