16 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
17 becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
19 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

21 the members of this body commend Cole D. Golden for his diligence and dedication in
