4 WHEREAS, at age 16, Colt founded the Georgia-registered nonprofit corporation,
5 International Music and Entertainment Association, Inc., and serves as CEO of the
6 corporation; and

7 WHEREAS, he attended the Nashville School of the Arts from 2009-2010 to pursue his high
8 school diploma with a specialization in Musical Theatre and Vocal Expression; and

9 WHEREAS, Colt has been extremely involved with the Polk, Gordon, and Floyd counties'
10 community arts programs, including the Rockmart Civic Arts Commission and the
11 Cedartown Civic Arts Commission (Cedartown Performing Arts Center); and he also serves
12 on the Board of Directors of the CCAC; and

14 Christmas parade and tourism committees; and

15 WHEREAS, Colt serves on the Industry Host Committee for the Georgia Music Awards
16 presented each June; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the remarkable achievements of this
18 young man are appropriately recognized.
