A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Emmanuel Nwosu; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Emmanuel Nwosu on January 29, 2013; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Nwosu was born on September 17, 1958, in Zaria, a northern region of
5 Nigeria; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he earned his bachelor's degree in political science from the University of
7 Alabama; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Mr. Nwosu was known for his willingness to help others whether through his
9 entrepreneurial efforts in helping individuals in his community start their own businesses,
10 or through his involvement in nonprofit organizations such as a food bank in Austell,
11 Georgia; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
13 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
14 family and friends were admired by others; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
16 for integrity, intelligence, service, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his
17 life, he made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 18 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. Emmanuel Nwosu will long be
19 remembered for his love of family and friendship, and this loyal public servant and friend
20 will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
22 join in honoring the life and memory of Mr. Emmanuel Emenike Nwosu and express their
23 deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.
