A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-6-393 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 homicide by vehicle, so as to increase the penalty for homicide by vehicle in the second
- 3 degree from a misdemeanor to a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated nature; to provide
- 4 for related matters; to provide for an effective date and applicability; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 40-6-393 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to homicide by
- 9 vehicle, is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:
- 10 "(c) Any person who causes the death of another person, without an intention to do so, by
- violating any provision of this title other than subsection (a) of Code Section 40-6-163,
- 12 subsection (b) of Code Section 40-6-270, Code Section 40-6-390 or 40-6-391, or
- subsection (a) of Code Section 40-6-395 commits the offense of homicide by vehicle in the
- second degree when such violation is the cause of said such death and, upon conviction
- thereof, shall be punished as provided in Code Section 17-10-3 <u>17-10-4</u>."

SECTION 2.

- 17 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2013, shall apply to all offenses committed on and
- 18 after such date.

19 SECTION 3.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
