A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing March 7, 2013, as Conditioned Air Association of Georgia Day at the state
2 capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Conditioned Air Association of Georgia (CAAG) is a state-wide, nonprofit
4 trade association which represents heating, ventilation, air conditioning, and refrigeration
5 contractors (HVACR) throughout the State of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, these contractors install, service, and repair systems on residential, commercial,
7 and industrial construction projects; and

8 WHEREAS, these contractors are licensed by the state for the purpose of safeguarding
9 homeowners, other property owners, tenants, and the general public against faulty,
10 inadequate, inefficient, or unsafe conditioned air installation; and

11 WHEREAS, the practice of conditioned air contracting is declared to be businesses or
12 professions affecting the public interest; and

13 WHEREAS, many of these contractors are also licensed by the state to work as plumbers,
14 electricians, and on boilers; and

15 WHEREAS, CAAG has over 1,000 company members in ten local chapters around the state;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, these companies employ thousands of hardworking, dedicated employees; and

18 WHEREAS, the membership is composed of a great diversity in sizes of member firms from
19 the very large mechanical contractors to the very small family owned businesses; and

20 WHEREAS, regardless of the size, CAAG represents the professionals in the industry who
21 have a genuine interest in improving the industry for both the customer and the contractor;

23 WHEREAS, CAAG's goal is to promote quality and professionalism in the HVACR industry
24 in the State of Georgia and the demonstration of a genuine concern for the satisfaction of
25 their customers by providing quality service.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
27 the members of this body recognize March 7, 2013, as Conditioned Air Association of
28 Georgia Day at the state capitol and commend these HVACR contractors on their many
29 outstanding accomplishments in the name of making the state a more comfortable
30 environment in which to live, work, and play.
