A RESOLUTION

5 WHEREAS, she has served 32 years as a trade unionist, working as Chief/Senior Job
6 Steward of Communication Workers of America (CWA) from 1995 to 2008, and now works
7 as political director and serves as the vice chair of the state political board for CWA,

10 and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of workers in this
11 state have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and

13 Community Services Evangelistic New Life Church, where she serves as president; and

14 WHEREAS, a woman admired for her intelligence, Ms. Scott attended Miami Dade College,
15 where she majored in Business Administration, attended the George Meany Center's 2002
16 certificate program in Labor Studies, and is a 2009 graduate of the Georgia Stand-Up
17 program of the School of Policy Institute and Urban Development; and

18 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that her vision and unyielding commitment on behalf of
19 workers and workers' rights at the state and federal level be appropriately recognized.
