- 3 WHEREAS, Mr. Stetson F. Bennett, Jr., was born in Wayne County and is the son of Stetson
- 4 F. Bennett, Sr., and Irene Little Bennett; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he graduated from Jesup High School and attended Auburn University; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Mr. Bennett is united in love and marriage to Patricia Jones and the two have
- 7 been blessed with three remarkable daughters, Tricia Armstrong Neace, Frances Yeargan,
- 8 and Vi Bennett; four beloved grandchildren; and eight cherished great-grandchildren; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Bennett began working in the Wayne County Clerk's Office in 1949 as
- 10 Chief Deputy Clerk after his father was elected to the office of Clerk of Superior Court; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he was first elected as clerk in 1964 and has held the office for 47 years; he
- 12 currently serves as the Clerk of Superior Court, State Court, Juvenile Court, and Drug Court
- and is the longest serving Constitutional Officer in the State of Georgia; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Mr. Bennett has continued to be active in the community affairs of Wayne
- 15 County by serving as past president of the Wayne County Chamber of Commerce and a
- member of the Lions Club, the Kiwanis Club, and the Masons of Georgia; and
- 17 WHEREAS, he has been a member on the hospital board, which was instrumental in the
- 18 development and construction of Wayne Memorial Hospital; a founding member of the Jesup
- 19 Jaycees; and part of a small group of citizens who worked diligently on the state level for
- 20 securing Wayne County as the main campus for Altamaha Technical College; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Bennett served as aide to former Georgia Governor Carl Sanders, a member

- 22 of the Georgia State Board of Corrections, and a participating member in the Georgia
- 23 Goodwill Tour, a group that traveled to Europe and behind the Iron Curtain to act as
- 24 ambassadors during the Khrushchev regime; and
- 25 WHEREAS, he is past president of the Georgia Superior Court Clerks and former chairman
- 26 of the Georgia Superior Court Clerks' Retirement Board; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Mr. Bennett was the first recipient of the prestigious Superior Court Clerk of
- 28 the Year Award for the State of Georgia in 1985, which has since been renamed the Stetson
- 29 F. Bennett Superior Court Clerk of the Year Award; and
- 30 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Mr. Bennett is a member of Little Creek
- 31 Baptist Church, where he has served as Sunday School Superintendent and deacon; and
- 32 WHEREAS, Mr. Stetson F. Bennett, Jr., is a man who is proud to claim Wayne County as
- 33 his dwelling place, America as his nation, and Christ as his Savior, and it is abundantly
- 34 fitting and proper that this exemplary Georgian be recognized.
- 35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 36 the members of this body commend Mr. Stetson F. Bennett, Jr., on 47 years of devoted
- 37 service to this state and extend their sincere best wishes for continued health and happiness.
