A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending State Representative Gloria Frazier; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, State Representative Gloria Frazier has long been recognized by the citizens of
3 this state for the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal
4 commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, she was born and raised in Greenwood, a small town outside of Shreveport,
6 Louisiana, and graduated from Bethune Jr/Sr. High School in 1973; and

7 WHEREAS, after graduation, she moved to Dallas, Texas, and attended El Centro Junior
8 College and worked for the Texas Instruments Corporation; and

9 WHEREAS, State Representative Frazier later married Sergeant Wayne Frazier of the United
10 States Army, and their union produced two beloved and beautiful daughters, Alicia and
11 LeKendrea; and she also has two wonderful grandsons, Khyree and Averii; and

12 WHEREAS, she spent 23 years as a devoted military wife, raising her two daughters while
13 stationed at many places, including Ft. Hood in Killen, Texas, Ft. Dix in New Jersey, and
14 traveled to Switzerland, Amsterdam, France, and Czechoslovakia; and

15 WHEREAS, she attended the overseas campus of the University of Maryland's business
16 administration program for two years, gaining extensive training in budgeting and finance
17 and working ten years in civil service for the United States government, and is a graduate of
18 the Military Real Estate School in Augusta, Georgia; and

19 WHEREAS, she was elected into the Georgia House of Representatives on January 8, 2007,
20 representing constituents in Richmond and Burke counties; and she is currently serving on
21 the Banks and Banking, Public Safety and Homeland Security, and Energy, Utilities, and
22 Telecommunications committees; and

23 WHEREAS, this distinguished individual is treasurer of the Georgia Women's Legislative
24 Caucus, past president of the Richmond County Neighborhood Association Alliance, Inc.,
25 where she received the highest individual achievement award, and past president of the
26 Walton Farms Neighborhood Association; and

27 WHEREAS, she has served on several local boards, including the Augusta-Richmond
28 County Tax Assessors Board and the Community Mental Health Board of East Central
29 Georgia, and currently works for the Richmond County Board of Education's Title I office
30 in administration, finance, and accounting; and

31 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
32 remarkable individual be appropriately recognized.
