

Senators Jackson of the 2nd and Henson of the 41st offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend SB 236 (LC 37 1582) by deleting lines 2 through 4 and inserting the following:*  
2 provide that insurers issuing accident and sickness policies in this state may indicate on their  
3 premium statements to consumers the amount of the premium increase or decrease  
4 attributable to the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act; to provide for other  
5 information; to provide for optional publication; to provide for related matters; to repeal

6 *By striking lines 14 and 15 and lines 23 and 24 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:*  
7 (b) Notice of any premium increase or decrease may include how much of such increase  
8 or decrease is attributable to the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. In the  
9 event an insurer chooses to include such information, the determination shall include,  
10 without limitation, direct costs and any savings due to expanded coverage or expanded  
11 access to preventive care. The insurer shall also publish on its website the methodology  
12 utilized in making such determination."
