A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Habitat for Humanity and recognizing March 20, 2013, as "Habitat for
- 2 Humanity Day" at the state capitol; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity is a global nonprofit Christian housing organization that
- 4 seeks to put God's love into action by bringing people together to build homes, communities,
- 5 and hope; and
- WHEREAS, since its founding in Americus, Georgia, in 1976, Habitat for Humanity has
 served more than 600,000 families worldwide by welcoming people of all races, religions,
 and nationalities to construct, rehabilitate, or preserve homes; by advocating for fair and just
 housing policies; and by providing training and access to resources to help families improve
 their shelter conditions; and
- WHEREAS, Georgians from all 159 counties have volunteered their time, talents, and resources to create 70 local Habitat for Humanity affiliates to help their fellow Georgians
- 13 meet their shelter needs; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity of Georgia, the state support organization for these 70
- 15 local Habitat affiliates, was incorporated on January 14, 2009; and
- WHEREAS, since 1976, Habitat for Humanity affiliates have built and sold more than 4,633
 homes with 4,633 hard-working families in the State of Georgia, financing them with zero
 interest loans; and
- 18 interest loans; and
- WHEREAS, in addition to building homes, Habitat for Humanity affiliates have providedservice to 682 Georgia families with home repairs and rehabilitations; and
- WHEREAS, the combined economic impact of this construction activity on the Georgia
 economy in 2012 was approximately \$2.6 billion; and

- 23 WHEREAS, 31 Habitat for humanity ReStores have generated over \$420,000.00 in sales tax
- 24 revenue to the State of Georgia from the sale of discounted building materials, home
- 25 furnishings, and appliances to Georgia residents wanting to preserve home ownership; and
- WHEREAS, it is fitting to set aside time and recognize the efforts of Habitat for Humanityin Georgia over the last 26 years.
- 28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 29 commend Habitat for Humanity on their significant contributions to the community and
- 30 recognize March 20, 2013, as "Habitat for Humanity Day."
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Habitat for Humanity.
