A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Democratic Women's Council of Douglas County; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Democratic Women's Council of Douglas County has long been recognized
4 by the citizens of this state for its vital role in leadership and its deep personal commitment
5 to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, the DWC-DC abides by the laws, rules, regulations, and policies of the Georgia
7 Federation of Democratic Women and makes every effort to work in harmony with other
8 Democratic parties in its area, including the Douglas County Democratic Party, the
9 Democratic Party of Georgia, and the National Democratic Party; and

10 WHEREAS, it has many duties and responsibilities, including supporting the principles and
11 platform of the Democratic Party, working for Democratic Party candidates during elections,
12 advocating for a fair and honest electoral process, initiating and carrying out support

16 public office, encourages and mentors young women as future leaders within the Democratic
17 Party, and encourages and supports the continued participation by women of all ages, races,
18 and religions in the planning and decision making of the DWC-DC; and

19 WHEREAS, under the astute direction of President Myesha Good, the Democratic Women's
20 Council of Douglas County has shown an unyielding commitment and dedication to the
21 principles of the Democratic Party, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that it be
22 appropriately recognized.
