A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Hispanic National Bar Association; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the mission of the Hispanic National Bar Association is to serve as a national
4 voice for the concerns and opinions of Hispanics in the United States generally, and in the
5 legal profession in particular; and

6 WHEREAS, the association strives to promote the recruitment and retention of Hispanics in
7 law school and provide them with financial assistance; and

8 WHEREAS, it is also committed to developing mechanisms to facilitate the exchange of
9 information among Hispanics involved in all segments of the legal profession; and

10 WHEREAS, the Hispanic National Bar Association conducts conventions and seminars in
11 order to provide continuing legal education for attorneys and foster the exchange of ideas
12 among its members; and

13 WHEREAS, the association provides testimony before Congress, state legislatures, and
14 executive agencies on issues of concern to Hispanics; and

15 WHEREAS, the Hispanic National Bar Association aims to work with other bar associations,
16 governmental agencies, and community groups to achieve greater involvement in and
17 understanding of the American legal system by the Hispanic community.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body recognize the Hispanic National Bar Association for their
20 commitment to serving the Hispanic community, commend the organization for its high
21 standards of service and dedication to excellence, and extend their sincere best wishes for
22 future success.
