3 with the passing of Michael Andrew "Drew" Wilson II; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Drew was born on April 23, 1964, the same day President Lyndon Johnson
5 spoke at Roosevelt Square in Drew's hometown of Gainesville, Georgia, to the late Michael
6 Andrew Wilson and Janis Miller Wilson; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he was a graduate of Gainesville High School where he played on the 1981
8 State Semifinal AAA team as an offensive left tackle; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he was involved in many activities around the community, including Boy
10 Scouts, Young Life, Student Government, and the Key Club, where he served as president;

- 12 WHEREAS, after high school, Drew attended Emory University at Oxford and the
13 University of Georgia, where he graduated with a degree in economics; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Drew was president of ECOM America, and he enjoyed being outdoors,
15 golfing, boating, and fishing on the coast of Georgia; and
- 16 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, he was a member of Gainesville First United
17 Methodist Church; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Drew is survived by his wife and children, Dana Rowe, Emmeline, Dickens,
19 and Rowe Wilson; his mother, Janis Wilson; brother and sister-in-law, Mitchell and Ansely

20 Wilson; niece and nephew, Ella and Miller Wilson; and a host of other family, friends, and
21 loved ones; and

22 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Drew will long be remembered for his love
23 of family and friendship, and he will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing
24 him.
