#### A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Gainesville High School girls golf team on their Class AAA State  
2 Championship win; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, through perseverance and unwavering determination, the Gainesville High  
4 School girls golf team won the Class AAA State Championship; and

5 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of the team is a clear indication of the outstanding

16 abundantly proper to call them champions.
