

Senate Bill 260

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act changing the compensation of the clerk of the superior court, the sheriff,
2 and the judge of the Probate Court of Cobb County from the fee system to the salary system,
3 approved February 9, 1949 (Ga. L. 1949, p. 427), as amended, particularly by an Act
4 approved May 12, 2008 (Ga. L. 2008, p. 3728), so as to change the compensation of the
5 chief deputy, the chief investigator, and the executive assistant to the sheriff; to provide for
6 related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
7 purposes.

8 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 An Act changing the compensation of the clerk of the superior court, the sheriff, and the
11 judge of the Probate Court of Cobb County from the fee system to the salary system,
12 approved February 9, 1949 (Ga. L. 1949, p. 427), as amended, particularly by an Act
13 approved May 12, 2008 (Ga. L. 2008, p. 3728), is amended by revising subsections (b), (c),
14 and (d) of Section 5 as follows:

15 "(b) The sheriff of Cobb County shall have one chief deputy whose salary shall be
16 \$123,356.77 per annum, to be paid in equal monthly installments from the funds of Cobb
17 County. The chief deputy sheriff shall possess the same qualifications for office as
18 required for the sheriff. The chief deputy shall serve at the pleasure of the sheriff. Each
19 candidate for the office of sheriff of Cobb County shall, at the time he or she qualifies to
20 run for the office of sheriff, designate and certify to the judge of the probate court the name
21 of the person who shall be his or her chief deputy sheriff. In the event the office of sheriff
22 becomes vacant by death, resignation, or otherwise, the vacancy shall be filled until the
23 next general election by said chief deputy, who shall in such event enter upon the
24 performance of said duties upon taking the oath of office prescribed by law for the sheriff
25 of Cobb County. The chief deputy sheriff is authorized, when directed by the sheriff, to
26 discharge any and all of the duties and powers of the sheriff. In addition to said chief
27 deputy, said sheriff shall be authorized to name and appoint such additional deputies as

28 shall be approved from time to time by the governing authority of Cobb County. The
29 salaries of said additional deputies shall be set by the governing authority of Cobb County;
30 provided, however, that said salaries shall not be less than \$4,880.00 per annum per each
31 additional deputy approved by said governing authority of Cobb County. In addition to
32 said chief deputy and other deputies provided for in this subsection, the sheriff of Cobb
33 County shall be authorized to employ the clerical help necessary to perform properly the
34 functions and duties of his or her office, provided that the number of employees and
35 salaries or other compensation to be paid to each shall first be approved by the governing
36 authority of Cobb County.

37 (c) In addition to those employees provided for by subsection (b) of this section, there is
38 created the office of chief investigator for Cobb County. The chief investigator shall be
39 appointed by the sheriff, shall be under his or her direct supervision and control, and shall
40 serve at the pleasure of the sheriff. The individual appointed by the sheriff of Cobb County
41 shall possess, as a minimum, a high school education or its equivalent and shall either be
42 a graduate of the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Academy for Peace Officers
43 or possess ten years of actual experience as a peace officer or be a graduate of a law school
44 accredited by the Georgia Bar Association or be a graduate of the Southern Police Institute
45 School of Police Management and Administration or have a master's degree from an
46 accredited college or university. The salary of the chief investigator shall be \$111,928.78
47 per annum, to be paid in equal monthly installments from the funds of Cobb County.

48 (d) In addition to those employees provided for in subsections (b) and (c) of this section,
49 there is created the position of executive assistant to the sheriff. The executive assistant
50 shall be appointed by the sheriff, shall be under his or her direct supervision and control,
51 and shall serve at the pleasure of the sheriff. The sheriff shall establish such qualifications,
52 education, and experience as he or she deems necessary for the individual appointed to the
53 position of executive assistant. The salary of the executive assistant shall be \$67,277.99
54 per annum, to be paid in equal monthly installments from the funds of Cobb County."

55 **SECTION 2.**

56 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
57 without such approval.

58 **SECTION 3.**

59 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
