A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act to create the Heart of Georgia Regional Airport Authority, approved
- 2 April 18, 1995 (Ga. L. 1995, p. 4448), as amended, so as to abolish the authority; to transfer
- 3 all powers, powers, duties, assets, property, liabilities, and indebtedness of the authority to
- 4 the Dodge County-Eastman Development Authority; to provide for related matters; to
- 5 provide a contingent effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 An Act to create the Heart of Georgia Regional Airport Authority, approved April 18, 1995
- 9 (Ga. L. 1995, p. 4448), and all amendatory Acts thereto are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2.

- 11 On the effective date of this Act, the Heart of Georgia Regional Airport Authority is
- 12 abolished and all powers, duties, assets, real and personal property, liabilities, and
- 13 indebtedness of the authority are transferred to the Dodge County-Eastman Development
- 14 Authority. The Dodge County-Eastman Development Authority shall be the successor to the
- 15 Heart of Georgia Regional Airport Authority in all contracts entered into by the Heart of
- 16 Georgia Regional Airport Authority which are in existence on the effective date of this Act
- 17 and to all accounts of and debts owed to the Heart of Georgia Regional Airport Authority that
- are outstanding on the effective date of this Act.

19 SECTION 3.

- 20 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 21 without such approval, provided that an Act changing the membership of the Dodge
- 22 County-Eastman Development Authority and transferring all of the assets and liabilities of
- 23 the Heart of Georgia Regional Airport Authority to the Dodge County-Eastman Development

24 Authority is enacted by the General Assembly during the same session. If no such Act is

25 enacted, this Act shall not become effective and shall be repealed by operation of law.

SECTION 4.

27 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
