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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 43-9-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	definitions relative to licensure and regulation of chiropractors, so as to revise the definition
3	of the practice of chiropractic; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
4	for other purposes.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
6	SECTION 1.
7	Code Section 43-9-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions
8	relative to licensure and regulation of chiropractors, is amended by revising paragraph (3)
9	as follows:
10	"(3) 'Practice of chiropractic' shall also include peer review which is defined as the
11	procedure by which chiropractors licensed in this state evaluate the quality and efficiency
12	of services ordered or performed by other chiropractors, including but not limited to
13	practice analysis, diagnosis, audit, claims review, underwriting assistance, utilization
14	review, and compliance with applicable laws, rules, and regulations."
15	SECTION 2.

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
