#### A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating Mr. Bob Swoszowski on being inducted into the Northeast Georgia Business  
2 Hall of Fame; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Bob Swoszowski received both his graduate and master's degree from  
4 Florida State University where he played college football; and

5 WHEREAS, in the 1970s, Mr. Swoszowski became one of the youngest franchisees to be  
6 approved as an owner/operator of McDonald's restaurants and today owns 11 restaurants
