A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Bob Plemons on the occasion of his retirement; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Bob Plemons has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital
4 role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare of the
5 citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, from 1973 to 1993, he served as a purchasing agent with Catoosa County, in
7 1994, became county manager with Gilmer County, and also held the position of volunteer
8 chairman for the State Soil and Water Conservation Commission; and

9 WHEREAS, from 1991 to 1999, he served as a board member for the Department of
10 Corrections and his commitment to public service continued in 1998 when he became special
11 projects manager with Chattooga County; and

12 WHEREAS, soon thereafter, he was hired as an administrative specialist 1 in engineering,
13 promoted to manager 2 in engineering, then became assistant to the director of Engineering
14 and Construction Services of the Department of Corrections; and

15 WHEREAS, in 2006, Bob became the Engineering and Construction Services assistant
16 director – chief-of-staff, and in 2009, he assumed additional duties as legislative liaison for
17 the Department of Corrections; and

18 WHEREAS, many refer to Bob as the "ambassador for the Department of Corrections"
19 because of his significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience and
20 diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this
21 state; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding contributions of this
23 remarkable individual be appropriately recognized.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
25 the members of this body recognize and commend Bob Plemons on the occasion of his
26 retirement and extend to him best wishes for continued health and happiness.
