A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the memory of Mr. Richard Pettys; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
- 3 with the passing of Mr. Richard "Dick" Pettys on October 8, 2012; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Pettys was born on November 25, 1946, in Atlanta, Georgia, and attended
- 5 North Fulton High School; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he was a loving husband to Marian Stephanie Suessmith and a devoted father
- 7 to their three remarkable sons, Richard R. Pettys, Jr., William H. Pettys II, and Clement N.
- 8 Pettys; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Pettys diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his
- 10 time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of this state as evidenced dramatically by his
- 11 more than three decades of dedicated service as a reporter covering politics and state
- 12 government for the Associated Press; and
- 13 WHEREAS, during his tenure with the Associated Press, he was responsible for keeping
- 14 politicians honest, and no one had a greater depth of knowledge about what was happening
- 15 in the political and corporate communities in our state, a knowledge he used to keep the
- 16 public well informed and give public servants the ability to make better policy; and
- 17 WHEREAS, this beloved individual exhibited extraordinary devotion to duty, outstanding
- 18 loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all his endeavors, which have
- 19 been recognized by his associates under the gold dome and throughout state government; and
- 20 WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience
- 21 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, his knowledge of where to go and how to get the
- 22 story first, and his ability to work alongside the members of the General Assembly, gaining

23 their trust while remaining an honest critic, earned him the respect and admiration of his
24 colleagues, associates, and the members of this body; and

25 WHEREAS, Mr. Pettys was an honorable gentleman, a true scholar, a talented and outspoken
26 journalist, a good friend to many, a lover of PayDay candy bars and other excellent health
27 foods, and is sorely missed by all who knew him; and

28 WHEREAS, it is said that there is no better eulogy for a journalist than to say he was a great
29 reporter, and Mr. Richard Pettys was a great reporter.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
31 the members of this body honor the life and memory of Mr. Richard Pettys, recognize his
32 many years of efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated public service to the citizens of
