21 citizens of this state have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and

24 been blessed with five remarkable sons and eight cherished grandchildren; and

25 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
26 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

27 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hollis served with honor and distinction with the Georgia General
28 Assembly through 40 legislative sessions, and her vision and unyielding commitment will
29 be sorely missed upon the occasion of her retirement; and

31 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
