A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Captain Kirk B. McGlamery on the occasion of his
2 retirement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on July 16, 1983, Kirk B. McGlamery was hired by the Georgia Department of
4 Public Safety as a radio operator trainee and was assigned to Georgia State Patrol Post #42,
5 Savannah; and

6 WHEREAS, he served as a radio operator at Post #42, Savannah and Post #45, Statesboro
7 for three years before being promoted to Trooper at Headquarters Security in Atlanta
8 Headquarters in July 1986; and

9 WHEREAS, in 1989, Trooper McGlamery was awarded the Department Valor Award for
10 heroic actions above and beyond the call of duty; he was subsequently nominated for and
11 received the Peace Officers' Association of Georgia Valor Award for 1990; and

12 WHEREAS, he was promoted to the rank of Corporal in September 1994 and transferred to
13 Post #23, Brunswick, where he served until he was transferred back to Post #42, Savannah
14 in June 1996; and

15 WHEREAS, his promotion to the rank of Sergeant occurred in September 1997 at Savannah
16 and he was designated as the Troop I Drug Interdiction Commander; and

17 WHEREAS, in July 1999, he was promoted to Sergeant First Class and transferred to Post
18 #18, Reidsville as the Post Commander, where he served until he was transferred to Post #45
19 in July 2001; and

20 WHEREAS, in April 2003, Captain McGlamery was promoted to Lieutenant, Assistant
21 Troop I Commander and was immediately tasked with developing the State of Georgia's
22 Transportation and Traffic Plan for the G-8 Summit held in June 2004; and

23 WHEREAS, in April 2005, he was promoted to the rank of Captain and assigned to the State
24 of Georgia's Regional K-9 Unit in Savannah at the Chatham County Sheriff's Office and, in
25 March 2008, he was transferred to Troop F as the Troop Commander; and

26 WHEREAS, Captain McGlamery's decades of exemplary service to the citizens of the State
27 of Georgia and dedication to the sound principles of law enforcement are commendable, and
28 it is abundantly fitting and proper that he be recognized.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
30 the members of this body recognize Captain Kirk B. McGlamery for his years of dedicated
31 service with the Georgia Department of Public Safety; commend him upon the grand
32 occasion of his retirement; and extend their sincere best wishes for his continued health and
33 happiness.
