A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Mr. Jon Lindsey, the Class A 2012 Football Coach of the Year; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Jon Lindsey exemplifies the selfless dedication that is characteristic of our
4 finest coaches, dedicating his time, talents, and energy to challenging and inspiring the future
5 athletes of this state and, as a result, is being recognized by the Atlanta Falcons as the Class
6 A 2012 Football Coach of the Year; and

7 WHEREAS, the former Camden County defensive coordinator spent the first seven years of
8 his career in education in Paulding and Cobb counties as a teacher and football and track
9 coach; and

10 WHEREAS, at Hiram High School, he was named the Track Region Coach of the Year and
11 his team was named the Boys Track State Runner-up in 2004; and

12 WHEREAS, in the summer of 2005, Coach Lindsey and his family moved to Camden
13 County where he began serving as a varsity football assistant and head track coach; in 2008
14 and 2009, he served as the co-defensive coordinator for the Camden Wildcats, and in 2010,
15 he was the sole defensive coordinator; and

16 WHEREAS, he and his family moved to Ocilla in 2011 after Coach Lindsey was named the
17 head coach of the Irwin County Indians; and

18 WHEREAS, Coach Lindsey led the Indians to a 7-3 record and a spot in the Class A playoffs
19 this season; and

20 WHEREAS, the dedication of Mr. Jon Lindsey to his students is worthy of recognition.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
22 commend Mr. Jon Lindsey, the Class A 2012 Football Coach of the Year, and express to him
23 their most sincere best wishes for continued success in the future.
