A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Chesley Phillip Robuck; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Chesley Phillip Robuck was born in Greenwood, South Carolina, on February
3 7, 1938, where he attended Lander College from 1956-1960, and moved to Acworth,
4 Georgia, in 1960; and

5 WHEREAS, Phillip's immediate family consisted of wife Winona Babb Robuck of 48 years
6 until her death in 2012, and daughter Regina K. Robuck; Phillip coached T-Ball and softball
7 throughout her life, and in 1968, Phillip's family was named "Family of the Year," by the Jr.
8 Woman's Club; and

9 WHEREAS, Phillip's work history included teacher at North Cobb High School (1960-1967),
10 Ivan Allen Company (1967-1972), West Paces Ferry Hospital (1972-1974), WSB TV and
11 Radio (1974-1980), Cobb County Board of Education (1980-2000), from which he retired
12 in 2000, and Lacey Drug Company to present; Phillip also assisted with the first integration
13 of an African American teacher in Cobb County; and

14 WHEREAS, Phillip has been recognized throughout his lifetime for various awards and
15 dedications that include "Outstanding Man of the Year" (1963), "Outstanding Civic Leader
16 of America" (1965, 1967), dedication of North Cobb High School's yearbook (1967), North
17 Cobb High School football announcer, "Voice of the Warriors" (1962-1988), "Kiwanis
18 Hickson Award" (2004), and induction into the North Cobb High School Athletics Hall of
19 Fame (2009); and

20 WHEREAS, Phillip has served on various boards and commissions that include City Council
21 (1969-1972), Vice Chair and Chair of Recreation (1969-1972), Acworth Zoning
22 Commission, Kennworth Park Development Committee, Revitalization of Downtown
23 Acworth Committee, member of the Finance Committee at the Marietta First United
24 Methodist Church, Acworth Tourism Board (Vice Chair 2005 to present), North Georgia

25 State Fair Board (2004 to present), and Kiwanis (30 years of service, served as President and
26 as Lieutenant Governor 2006-2007).

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
28 the members of this body recognize and commend Chesley Phillip Robuck for his significant
29 contributions to the Acworth community.
