- 1 Requesting that the United States Congress allocate funding for the Dobbins Air Reserve
- 2 Base Commissary and extend the operation of the Fort McPherson Commissary; and for

- 4 WHEREAS, the United States Congress is requested to provide the funding allocation for
- 5 the United States Department of Defense Commissary Agency approved commissary for
- 6 Dobbins Air Reserve Base and to extend the operation of the United States Department of

- 9 WHEREAS, the authorization and allocation of funds for the construction of the United
- 10 States Department of Defense approved commissary at Dobbins Air Reserve Base would
- serve more than 80,000 authorized beneficiaries, including active component military, active
- duty members of the reserve components, retired military members, permanently disabled

- 14 WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Fort McPherson Commissary until the approved
- 15 commissary at Dobbins Air Reserve Base is prepared to open for business would greatly
- benefit all authorized and retired armed forces members, all disabled veterans, and their
- 17 families; and
- 18 WHEREAS, it is in the public relations interests of the United States to complete its promises
- 19 to the estimated 80,000 authorized beneficiaries of the United States Department of Defense
- 20 commissary and base exchange system in the Atlanta area.

- 22 the members of this body request that the United States Congress allocate funding for the
- 23 Dobbins Air Reserve Base Commissary and extend the operation of the Fort McPherson
