A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Columbia County School Superintendent Charles R. Nagle
2 on the occasion of his retirement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Superintendent Charles R. Nagle began his career in education in 1976 and
4 dedicated over 37 years to improving the lives of students as a teacher, coach, principal, and
5 associate superintendent; and

6 WHEREAS, he has served the citizens of Columbia County as their Superintendent of
7 Schools from 2007 to 2013; and

8 WHEREAS, Superintendent Nagle exemplifies the highest standards of leadership,
9 dedication, and commitment in his pursuit of excellence in education; and

10 WHEREAS, the Columbia County School System has made tremendous advancements and
11 progress under his leadership; and

12 WHEREAS, he has held numerous public forums to discuss rezoning options due to growth,
13 building five elementary schools, five middle schools, and one high school, and overseeing
14 classroom additions to ten elementary schools, two middle schools, and four high schools,
15 impacting well over 4000 families; and

16 WHEREAS, during his time of service, Superintendent Nagle has recognized the importance
17 of partnering with parents, teachers, and community leaders to achieve excellence in
18 education and has challenged the youth of Columbia County to advance to higher levels of
19 education and improve their quality of life; and

20 WHEREAS, his remarkable patience, diplomacy, integrity, and sensitivity to the needs of the
21 citizens of Columbia County have earned him the respect and admiration of students,
22 employees, and colleagues.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of the body
24 commend Superintendent Charles R. Nagle for his outstanding career in public education and
25 for his effective, unselfish, and dedicated public service to the citizens of Columbia County.
