

ADOPTED

Senator Shafer of the 48th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend HR 4 (LC 28 6429) by striking "the current boundary between the two states*
2 *reflecting" on line 17; by striking the period at the end of line 35 and inserting in lieu thereof*
3 *"; and"; and by inserting the following after line 35:*

4 WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Georgia desires to settle potential
5 litigation with the State of Tennessee regarding the proper location of the boundary line
6 between the states of Georgia and Tennessee on the terms and conditions set forth in this
7 resolution, but hereby reserves its right, if such offer is rejected by or not timely acted on by
8 the Tennessee legislature, to insist, in litigation or otherwise, on the true and correct
9 boundary line between the states of Georgia and Tennessee as the 35th parallel of north
10 latitude.

11 *By inserting after line 42 the following:*

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, if an agreement resolving the boundary dispute is not
13 reached as of the last day on which the General Assembly convenes in regular session in
14 2014, the Attorney General of Georgia is hereby authorized and directed to take such action
15 as is required to initiate suit in the United States Supreme Court against the State of
16 Tennessee for final settlement of the boundary issue.
