A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring and celebrating the 100th birthday of Mrs. Evelyn Wardlaw; and for other
2 purposes.

15 Court and worked for the Cobb County Board of Elections for 35 years at Lost Mountain as
16 an assistant manager and manager of the polling precinct; and

17 WHEREAS, this distinguished lady is renowned for her extremely generous hospitality and
18 has been an inspiration to everyone she has met through her high ideals, morals, and deep
19 concern for her fellow citizens; and

20 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
21 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she has made of her life,
22 she makes this world a better place in which to live; and it is only fitting and proper that she
23 be appropriately recognized at this very special time of her life.
