A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Robert Deadwyler; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, born in Atlanta, Georgia, Mr. Robert Deadwyler was a beloved son of Ralph
3 Campbell Deadwyler and Nellie Laura Greene and a wonderful brother to Gloria Jane; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Deadwyler was blessed with a loving wife Sue Ella Deadwyler, two
5 remarkable children, Robert Daniel and Ginger Sue, and three adorable grandchildren,
6 Amanda Cheree, Robert Daniel, Jr., and Chris Bailey; and
- 7 WHEREAS, a man of abiding faith in Jesus Christ, he had a deep love for God; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in high school he joined the ROTC, where he soon became Cadet Major Robert
9 Deadwyler, second in command as Battalion Executive Officer; and
- 10 WHEREAS, as a junior at Roosevelt High School, he enlisted in the Service Company,
11 122nd Infantry, Georgia National Guard, and at the end of his four-year term, he reached the
12 rank of Private First Class, was awarded an honorable discharge, and promptly reenlisted for
13 another three years, during which he reached the rank of Sergeant E-5; he then enlisted in the
14 U.S. Army Reserve and quickly attained the rank of Sergeant First Class; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Mr. Deadwyler had a natural mechanical engineering talent that allowed him
16 to drive, fix, modify, repair, improve, or invent practically anything, but which also enhanced
17 his love for the automotive field; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Mr. Deadwyler's passion for automotive vehicles extended beyond his working
19 life; he was a devoted NASCAR fan, and dedicated much of his time to classic car
20 restoration, including a classic metallic midnight blue Ford Mustang, his father's restored
21 1969 Chevrolet Impala, and a gold-metallic magnetic red 1999 Corvette; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Deadwyler was a compassionate and generous man who will long be
23 remembered for his love of family and friendship, and this loyal husband, father, grandfather,
24 and friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
