17 people in this state, it is abundantly fitting and proper to honor the outstanding
18 accomplishments of this remarkable individual.

20 the members of this body commend Mr. Samuel Bryant for his dedicated service to his
21 students, congratulate him for being named Morrow Middle School's 2012-2013 Teacher of
