Senators Carter of the 1st, Jeffares of the 17th, Staton of the 18th and Stone of the 23rd offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Ethics Committee substitute to HB 87 (LC 28 6790S) by inserting after*
 2 *"generally, is" on line 15 the following:*
 3 amended by revising paragraph (2) of subsection (c) and subparagraph (i)(1)(B) of Code
 4 Section 21-2-132, relating to filing notices of candidacy, nomination petitions, and affidavits,
 5 as follows:

6 "(2) Each candidate for a county ~~judicial~~ office, a local school board office, or an office
 7 of a consolidated government, or the candidate's agent, desiring to have his or her name
 8 placed on the nonpartisan election ballot shall file notice of candidacy in the office of the
 9 superintendent no earlier than 9:00 A.M. on the fourth Monday in April immediately
 10 prior to the election and no later than 12:00 Noon on the Friday following the fourth
 11 Monday in April, notwithstanding the fact that any such days may be legal holidays;"

12 "(B) Each candidate for a county ~~judicial~~ office, a local school board office, or an
 13 office of a consolidated government, or the candidate's agent, desiring to have his or her
 14 name placed on the nonpartisan election ballot shall file a notice of candidacy in the
 15 office of the superintendent at the same time as candidates for party nomination in the
 16 general primary as provided in paragraph (1) of subsection (c) of Code
 17 Section 21-2-153, notwithstanding the fact that any such days may be legal holidays;
 18 and"
